



CHATEAU CANON DE BREM, 2002

Medium to medium-full colour. Good richness and nice austerity on the nose. Medium-full body. Very good tannins. Good grip. There is plenty of depth and fruit here, and plenty of future. Long. Classy. Very good indeed. From 2008.

CHATEAU DE CARLES, 2002

Good colour. Quite a pronounced acidity on the nose. Good weight and depth. Plummy. Just a little tannin. Balanced. Fresh. Long. Quite good. From 2006.

CHATEAU CAROLUS, 2002

Fullish colour. Rich, quite oaky nose. Quite full. Rich, ripe and concentrated. Good grip. Plenty of depth and dimension. Still some tannin. Good energy. Very good plus. From 2009.

CHATEAU CHADENNE, 2002

Medium-full colour. Slightly closed-in on the nose. But there is fruit and depth and class here. Good structure. Medium-full body. Nice and ripe. Better tannins than most. This has harmony and dimension. Long and positive. Very good. From 2007/8.

CHATEAU LA CROIX CANON, 2002

Medium-full colour. Broad nose with a suggestion of reduction. Medium to medium-full body. Ample, ripe and fat. Not as tannic as some but the tannins are very ripe. Yet very good acidity. This has style and suppleness and plenty of energy. Very good indeed. From 2007.
